Arrival to the United Kingdom

Full day excursion to Cambridge and Greenwich

The day will start with a stop at Greenwich in the morning. You will visit the Royal Observatory where “time was invented”. Come and stand on the world-famous Greenwich Meridian Line, which represents the Prime Meridian of the World – longitude 0°. After a short break at Greenwich Market, we will head to Cambridge. Guided tour of Cambridge’s places of interest and optional visit to the Fitzwilliam Museum. We will enter Trinity College and you will have the chance to discover this exciting British city.

Entry to Trinity College and photo stop at Isaac Newton’s apple tree

Visiting Trinity College, a beautiful college that is part of the University of Cambridge. The apple tree outside the college gate is a direct descendant of the tree which dropped an apple on Isaac Newton's head, prompting him to evolve his theory of gravity.





Audio guide tour of the castle and its grounds are included in the trip.



Full day excursion to Oxford, inside visit to Christ Church, the Harry Potter College and visiting the Museum of the History of Science

Guided tour of Oxford including a visit to the world famous Oxford University college, Christ Church. Many of the scenes in the Harry Potter feature films are shot in various locations of the College and as you walk around the cloisters and quadrangles it is easy to see why. Follow in the footsteps of the world's favourite wizard through Oxford's most spectacular College. This day will give you an insight into the history of Oxford and its connection with Cambridge. You will also have the chance to discover the city's shopping streets during your free time.

Educational visit to the Museum of the History of Science (tour: 14:30 - 15:15)

These exhibits hold an important position in the cultural life of Oxford, and are housed in the world's first purpose-built museum. It is a must-see for visitors to the city. Exhibits on show include internationally significant collections of scientific instruments such as astrolabes and sundials, as well as famous objects such as Einstein's blackboard and equipment used in the development of penicillin as an antibiotic.

For an introduction to the Museum and its collections, you will take part in one of the museum's regular tours and your students will receive our tailor made trails with questions to complete for a prize.




