Entry to Trinity College and photo stop at Isaac Newton's apple tree



The Brighton Pavilion educational experience




In the early afternoon, we will head to the Ashford Outlet Centre. This is a great place for shopping and eating with its 70% discounted price offers.

Educational visit to the Museum of the History of Science (tour: 14:30 - 15:15)



Shakespeare's Globe Theatre Workshop and guided Globe Theatre tour


